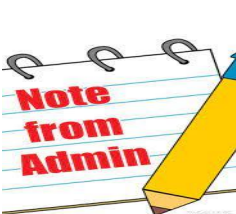

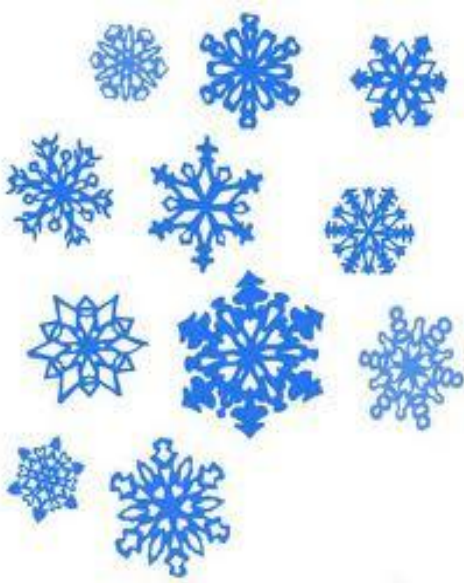
### A Note from Admin:

# Policy Review:



## Inclement Weather Policy:

If Baltimore City Public Schools close, delay opening, or close early due to inclement weather, City Neighbors Hamilton will close, delay opening, or close early for the corresponding amount of time.

In the event school opening is delayed, dismissal will be at the usual time: 3:00 on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays, and at 1:00 on Wednesdays. For example: If Baltimore City Public Schools open 2 hours late, then CNH will open at 10:00, including Wednesdays and any other “half-days.” In the case of a delayed opening on a Wednesday, dismissal will remain the same: 1 PM.

If Baltimore City Public Schools close 2 hours early on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, or Fridays, CNH will close at 1:00. If Baltimore City Public Schools close 2 hours early on a Wednesday or any other “half-days”, CNH will dismiss at the usual time: 1 PM.

There will be no aftercare or after-school activities on days when schools are closed or close early due to inclement weather.

All events scheduled for the morning when schools are closed or the opening is delayed, will be canceled. Breakfasts are not served at school on days when BCPSS delays opening. If BCPSS cancels its afterschool programs and events due to inclement weather, there will be no after school events at CNH, including aftercare.

**Please note: *If the temperature is 32 degrees or below, students will have indoor recess. We closely monitor the weather during the day, and will make appropriate changes as needed.***

## CURRENT FAMILIES AND STAFF

The deadline to receive applications for **siblings of current students** and children of school staff is **January 22, 2024**. If your child currently attends CNH, there is no need to reapply. Intent to Return forms will be sent and collected in January. Siblings and children of staff will not be included in the enrollment lottery, **HOWEVER**, you must submit an enrollment application by **January 22, 2024** in order for us to have an accurate count of open seats when we conduct our lottery.
