### Rising 5th-8th grade Camp:

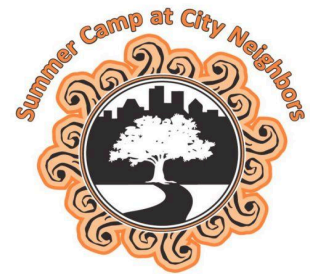

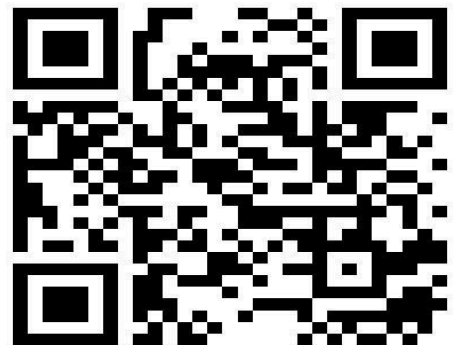


What are you doing for the month of July? Come join us for a fun and safe summer camp experience at City Neighbors Summer Program!!
