A Note from Admin

Greetings families,

As many of you know, City Neighbors Hamilton is up for renewal in 2025. This means that we will be diving into our School Effectiveness Review (SER) process.

The SER provides an objective and evidence-based analysis of how well a school is working to educate its students. It generates a layer of qualitative data that may not be revealed when evaluating a school solely on student performance outcomes. It also provides district and school-level staff with objective and useful information when making strategic decisions that impact student achievement. Here is some renewal history for CNH:

City Neighbors Hamilton opened in 2009 with a five year contract.

City Neighbors Hamilton received a 3 year renewal in 2014.

City Neighbors Hamilton received a 5 year renewal in 2017.

City Neighbors Hamilton received a 3 year renewal in 2022

In Spring 2024, our MCAP scores will count, our SER will take place, and all surveys, audits and data will be finalized.

We are preparing for a multi-day visit in April that will include:

- Observations
- Focus Groups
- Document Review

We will continue to update our community throughout this process. Thank you for your continued support of our community.




