We need you!

As you know, City Neighbors is in its renewal year. As a charter school, we have greater autonomy to create the project-based, arts-integrated, community school that we have. For that autonomy, we have greater accountability. Every few years, the District conducts a thorough study of our school and determines whether our schools should continue.

We have already been deep in that process. We have had a three day site visit - which we rocked! Our students and teachers completed a Chicago 5E Survey - which we rocked!. We have completed an audit of our Special Education practices, which we are awaiting results from (but we think we rocked). You have completed our Maryland Family Survey. And, we are currently taking the MCAP, whose scores will be factored into the District's decision.

Our last step in the process is the submission of an application. In addition to the application school staff will-written, we attach letters of support from families, teachers, and students, sharing their thoughts on our school's impact.

Please submit a letter of support. It does not need to be overly formal. It can be long; it can be short. It can be typed; it can be handwritten. As long as the letter says something about why City Neighbors deserves to keep doing our work, it will be a huge help!

You can submit your letter in one of two ways:

- 1. You can drop off your letter of support to the main office.

The number of letters we get matters. So, we hope everyone will take just a few minutes to support our renewal. Please submit letters by June 1, 2024.
