
Upcoming Fundraisers:

City Neighbors Hamilton is now accepting enrollment applications for next school year. The deadline to receive applications from **new families** for inclusion in the enrollment lottery is 3 PM February 2, 2024. Please spread the word!

CURRENT FAMILIES AND STAFF

The deadline to receive applications for **siblings** of current students and children of school staff is **January 22, 2024**. If your child currently attends CNH, there is no need to reapply. Intent to Return forms will be sent and collected in January. Siblings and children of staff will not be included in the enrollment lottery, **HOWEVER**, you must submit an enrollment application by **January 22, 2024** in order for us to have an accurate count of open seats when we conduct our lottery.
