One way that we cultivate this sort of development is by sharing many classroom materials and supplies in common. Thus, as you and your child prepare the school supplies listed below, you will notice that I request that some items be labeled with your child's name/ and some not. You may also notice that there are minimal art supplies on the list. The classroom has quite a few markers, crayons and tape currently, so although I may ask for these supplies later in the year, we don't need them now. I hope you and your child are enjoying the specialness of summer, and look forward to meeting you soon.

## **Please label these items with your child's first and last name:**

- 1 3 ring binder, 1"
- 3 wide-ruled marble-cover composition book (any brand)
- 3 heavy-duty plastic pocket folders (one bottom pocket on each side) in the following colors: 1 red, 1 yellow, 1 blue
- 1 backpack
- oversized t-shirt to use as a smock
- 1 small blanket (for example, crib-sized) or towel for quiet time
- 1 complete change of clothes to keep at school throughout the year/ including: underwear, socks, shoes, pants or skirt, and shirt. (Important: please label each item of clothing with your child's name and seal in a large Ziploc bag.)

## **Please do not label these items:**

- 1 pack of 4 standard-size glue sticks (any brand)
- 1 box unscented tissues (any brand)
- 1 pump-dispenser of liquid hand soap (any brand)
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 ream of copy paper
- 1 package of plastic sheet protectors
- 1 bottle Elmer's glue
- Children with last names A-M 1 pack blank 3x5 white index cards; 1 package flair felt tip black pens
- Children with last names N-Z: 1 pack Sharpie permanent markers, black or colored; 1 package flair felt tip colored pens

You can drop off these materials in the kindergarten classroom at any time, starting on the first day of school. \*\*\*A note about water bottles: water bottles are an important part of life in 3rd grade. Having a water bottle maximizes the amount of time your child is in the classroom, close to their learning. It also saves resources and is environmentally friendly.

- 5 heavy-duty **plastic** pocket folders (1 yellow, 1 blue, 1 red, 1 orange, 1 green, other colors okay if unavailable).
- 1 pocket folder, your choice of color/design (this will be your homework/take-home folder)
- 4 composition books **wide rule**
